Payment and/or Arrangements to Pay

Tuition and fees are due **before** June 02, 2008. Students unable to meet their financial obligations must make arrangements in the Business Office before May 30. Students receiving or planning to receive financial aid must have all paperwork completed and ready for charging by May 30. Checks, money orders, VISA or MasterCard payments should be made payable to *Connors State College*.

- **In Person:** Payments must be made in the Business Office, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus; or 1st Floor, Muskogee Downtown Campus. Bring summer bill, vehicle license tag number and current ID card for validation. Payments can be made by charging to prior approved financial aid, or by cash, check, or money order, VISA or Master Card. Students receiving funding through an outside agency must bring a letter of authorization from that agency to be able to process their registration-payment.
- **By Mail:** Mail check or money order, along with billing statement and social security number to: *Business Office, Connors State College, Route 1, Box 1000, Warner, OK 74469*. The Business Office will mail you a receipt. Take this receipt to the Business Office, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus; or the Business Office at the Muskogee Downtown Campus to validate your student ID card and obtain a summer parking permit for your vehicle.
- **Refunds:** Class schedule adjustments on or before June 05 will be charged in full for classes added. Complete withdrawals on or before June 05 will result in full refunds. First time enrolled Title IV financial recipients will be refunded as mandated by federal guidelines.

Cancelling Enrollment

Students are responsible for tuition and fee payments for classes in which they are enrolled. Non-attendance and/or non-payment do not constitute automatic withdrawal from classes. Students must cancel their enrollment in person or in writing by June 5, 2008 for a refund/no charges. After this date, all tuition and fee charges are due.

Adjustments to Schedule

Adjustment must be completed in the Admissions Office, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus or in the Admissions Office at the Muskogee Downtown Campus, first floor.

Withdrawing From All Classes

The withdrawal process begins in the Admissions Office at our Warner and Muskogee Downtown Campuses. The withdrawal form must be signed through the following offices: (1) Financial Aid, (2) Business Office, (3) Library, and (4) Admissions Office. ***The withdrawal form must be returned to the Admissions Office before the withdrawal process is complete.***

Car Permits and Student ID Cards

Students are required to have both a summer 2008 vehicle-parking permit and a summer validated ID card. Students are not considered registered for the semester until they have paid their tuition and fees, obtained a car permit and validated their ID card. Only first-time students will receive a new student ID card. Continuing students must bring their previous semester card for a validation sticker. Car permits and validation stickers are obtained once tuition and fees are paid. Students on the Warner Campus must take their current ID, license tag number and receipt showing payment of fees to the Business Office, Gatlin Hall. Students at the Muskogee Campus must report to the Business Office located on the first floor at the Downtown Campus. Students must park in designated areas outlined in the parking permit information.

Admissions Process at Connors State College

Before enrollment, the following must be on file in the Admissions/Registrar's Office.

FIRST-TIME COLLEGE STUDENTS

1. A completed Admissions Application
2. Students age **twenty (20) and younger** (high school class must have graduated) must provide:
 - a. An official high school transcript with date of graduation or last date of attendance
 - b. ACT or SAT scores
 - c. COMPASS Placement Test scores if ACT sub-scores are less than 19
3. Students age **twenty-one (21) or older** must provide:
 - a. COMPASS Placement Test (CPT) scores (may use ACT if sub-scores are 19 or above), or voluntary remediation of all courses
4. Provide immunization documentation

TRANSFER STUDENTS

1. A completed Admissions Application
2. Official transcript(s) from all colleges attended
3. An official high school transcript and ACT scores if student has earned fewer than 24 credit hours or if student seeks to prove history curricular requirement has been met
4. Provide immunization documentation

ENTRY-LEVEL ASSESSMENT

The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education have established minimum ACT Scores as the initial determinant for individual student readiness for college level work. Students who do not have the required ACT scores (19) in the various subject areas will be required to sit for the COMPASS test(s) to determine placement in developmental courses. COMPASS Testing takes from one to two hours to complete depending on the number of tests required. Please keep this in mind when you come to campus to enroll. COMPASS testing is conducted from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM daily at both the Main Campus in Warner and the Downtown Campus in Muskogee.
