

## Art Contest/Show/Auction TIP SHEET

Some of you may be asking how to obtain “Connors Centennial” themed art from children. Here are some ideas:

- ✚ Pick an interest of a child—buses, buildings, animals, cheerleaders and show them some of our old and/or current photos. Artists use photos for their “model”, so can children. For example, children can draw a bus “like the one in the picture”.
- ✚ Pick a theme, such as gardening or farming, and show children a photo gallery of related pictures. Have them choose a favorite picture and draw it.
- ✚ **PAST and PRESENT:** Young Children may not be able to conceptualize “100 years” but they can begin to understand “a long time ago”.... “We do things differently now, but here’s how they use to do it”...Understanding past and present is a good way to introduce history and culture to children AND it promotes diversity and tolerance as well.
- ✚ Provide the paper and the materials and let the child do his own thing. Be sure to ask the child to “name” his art...”Tell me about....”
- ✚ Remember we’d like to see art from children of all ages.
