

FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCE EDUCATION (FCSE)

- FCSE 1103 - Clothing Selection and Construction 3 Credits**
Class 1, Lab 4. This course includes the construction and care of clothing, selection of suitable fabrics and designs for the individual.
- FCSE 1113 - Home, Life, and Family Living 3 Credits**
Class 3. This class studies the individual and the family. Consideration of human development, behavior, and relationships with personal application to the individual and his family are explored.
- FCSE 1213 - Introduction to Nutrition 3 Credits**
Class 3. The consideration of basic nutrition related to food and health problems in the present socio-economic and cultural environment are included in this course.
- FCSE 1323 - Textiles 3 Credits**
Class 3. This course studies the selection of textiles and clothing with emphasis on aesthetic, sociological, and maintenance aspects.
- FCSE 2103 - Clothing 3 Credits**
Class 1, Lab 4. *Prerequisite: FCSE 1103 – Clothing Selection and Construction.* Clothing construction based on flat pattern designing with emphasis on principles of fitting and suitability of design for the individual.
- FCSE 2113 - Resource Management for Individual and Family 3 Credits**
Class 3. This course includes the principles and procedures of management with emphasis on money, time, and energy.
- FCSE 2114 - House Planning and Decoration 4 Credits**
Class 2, Lab 4. This course encompasses the study of houses from the standpoint of utility, beauty, and economy; includes elevation of house plans, and problems in various phases of interior decoration. Includes a brief historical survey of outstanding periods with emphasis on domestic architecture, furniture, and textiles.
- FCSE 2123 - Meal Management 3 Credits**
Class 3. *Prerequisite: FCSE 1213 – Introduction to Nutrition.* This course includes the planning, preparation, management, and simple service of food for family adapted to food habits, customs, economics, and social need.
- FCSE 2213 - Family Foods 3 Credits**
Class 2, Lab 3. The selection, preparation, management, and simple service of food adapted to family living patterns.
- FCSE 2322 - Nutrition for Children 2 Credits**
Class 2. This course includes the principles of nutrition applied to children’s needs. It also includes methods of implementing nutrition in the school and establishing favorable attitudes in food selection.
- FCSE 2300 - Special Topics 1-5 Credits**
Prerequisite: Consent of the instructor. The study and/or analysis of a selected topic in Family and Consumer Science Education. Individual and/or group study. May be repeated with a different topic.
