# GENERAL INFORMATION

## ENROLLMENT POLICY

Announcement will be made by the Admissions/Registrar's Office of the enrollment start date. Students must obtain a permit to enroll from the Admissions Office, complete an enrollment card with the assistance of an advisor and submit the card to the Admissions Office.

**NEW STUDENTS** should submit an application and other requirements at least one month prior to enrollment. For details contact the **Admissions Office, Gatlin Hall, 1st Floor, Warner Campus or the Muskogee Higher Education Center, Office of Admissions, 2400 W. Shawnee Bypass, Muskogee, OK 74402.**

**ENTRY LEVEL ASSESSMENT** is required for all first-time students seeking admission into degree programs. The purpose of assessment is to assist faculty and advisors in helping students to succeed in attaining their educational goals. Assessment is required in English, math, reading and science. All course remediation requirements must be completed within the first 24 credit hours.

**ALL FIRST-TIME FRESHMEN AND TRANSFER STUDENTS** are encouraged to enroll in EDUC 1113 STRATEGIES FOR SUCCESS.

**READMISSION OF FORMER STUDENTS** - Students who have attended CSC but have not been enrolled in more than one year must be readmitted. Students who have enrolled in another college since attending CSC must submit official transcripts (in a sealed envelope from the college/university attended) of all work attempted before readmission can be granted. For details, contact the **Admission/Registrar Office, 1st Floor, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus or Admission Office Muskogee Higher Education Center, Muskogee.**

**AN OUTCOMES ASSESSMENT** is required by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education and assesses skills in reading, English, science and mathematics. Students with 45 completed hours must enroll in **OUTCOMES ASSESSMENT (EDUC 2320). Outcomes Assessment is required for graduation and there is no cost for the test.**

**ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT SERVICES** will assist all students with the enrollment process. For details/assistance, contact the **VP for Enrollment Management and Student Services on the Warner Campus or any academic advisor at Warner or the Muskogee Higher Education Center.**

**FULL TIME STUDENTS** must be enrolled for 12 or more semester hours of credit. Summer semester full-time students must be enrolled in 6 to 10 hours. Part-time students enroll in 11 or fewer hours in the spring or fall and 5 hours or less in the summer.

**VETERANS** – All persons receiving VA educational benefits must report to the **VA Education Office at the Muskogee Higher Education Center (918) 687-6747, ext. 5443.** All class schedules must have prior approval to receive educational benefits. To determine eligibility, students should contact the **Department of Veterans' Affairs, toll free at 1-888-442-4551 or visit the VA Regional Office at Okmulgee and Main, Muskogee, Oklahoma.**

**VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION BENEFITS** are available through the Vocational Rehabilitation Division of the State Board of Education for payment of tuition and other services to students who have substantial employment handicaps. A representative of the Division must approve the vocational objective selected by the student. For additional information, contact your **county or regional Vocational Rehabilitation Office. ## **EVALUATION OF MILITARY CREDIT**

Connors State College does not automatically award military credit to students at the onset of enrollment. A military credential evaluation is optional and has no bearing on admission into Connors State College. However, after a degree-seeking student is at Connors State College and earned 12 hours, he or she may request that the military record be evaluated in the Registrar's Office. Credit is evaluated using the ACE Guide for evaluation of military credit (Army, Navy, Air Force, and Coast Guard). No credit will be awarded based on Military Occupancy Specialty (MOS) which has not been held a primary duty assignment for a minimum duration of one year or more.

It is the responsibility of the student to provide the information below for evaluation. Evaluation will begin upon receipt of the following documents.

- (1) Military Training Evaluation  
Send a copy of your DD-214 or a DD-295
- (2) MOS Evaluation  
Your current primary MOS can be reviewed for possible credit if you received an official evaluation within the last 12 months.

A student will not be certified for VA benefits after the first regular semester until the College's VA Certifying Officer has received the DD-214 and any other transcripts for evaluation.

Connors State College awards the credit listed below where appropriate to all veterans that have completed two years of active duty as verified by the veteran's DD-214.

HLTH 1113 Personal Health (3 credit hours)  
PHED 1112 First Aid (2 credit hours)

Students will be given Advanced Standing credit and charged \$10.00 per credit hour for the above hours. Credit earned is designated on the transcript by the letter "P".

## **C-KEY E-MAIL**

C-Key is Connors' identity management system. You can use the C-Key system to manage your login credentials for all CSC electronic computing systems or to update your contact information. Your C-Key e-mail address serves as the official CSC communication medium. Via this e-mail address, you will continually receive official CSC correspondence, updates, billing notification, and emergency announcements as well as enrollment information. At the beginning of each semester, temporary help desks will be available to assist you with the C-Key account creation process at each of our campuses.

Students should consider proper etiquette as well as the student code of conduct when writing and submitting e-mail to instructors and staff members. Using profane or otherwise abusive language can have a negative impact on the student's standing in a course as well as at CSC, possibly bringing disciplinary action.

**DEGREE PLANS** - Degree plans will remain in effect provided the student has had continuous enrollment. Students who leave and then reenter will be subject to any new degree or general education requirements. Students should have two degree checks during their enrollment, completed in the Admissions Office, one at the 35 hour mark and one the semester prior to graduating. Only those degree checks performed in the Admissions Office will be considered official for graduation.

**ACADEMIC FORGIVENESS POLICY** - Students may repeat up to four classes (not to exceed 18 hours) of "D" or "F" grades in their entire academic career and have only the last grade earned used in the calculation of the retention and graduation GPA. In certain circumstances, students may apply for an academic reprieve for up to two consecutive semesters of course work. Students must apply for academic renewal for removal of all previous coursework. **If repeating a course, it is necessary to complete a Request for Grade Repeat form in the Admission's Office.** For more information regarding the Academic Forgiveness Policy, contact the Admission's Office or the CSC catalog.

**ACADEMICALLY INELIGIBLE TO RE-ENROLL** - If you enroll early, and are found to be ineligible by the Connors State College admissions/enrollment standards, the Admission's Office will notify you and your enrollment will be canceled. Should you become academically ineligible and wish to appeal the decision, the first step in the appeal process is to submit a letter of appeal to the Executive Vice President, Office of the President, Connors State College, Route 1, Box 1000, Warner, OK 74469 *immediately* for consideration for re-admission.

**CLASS SCHEDULE CHANGES** - Changes in schedule during the add/drop period will result in full charges for courses added and full refund for courses dropped. Refunds will not be made until after the defined add/drop period.

**COLLECTION COSTS** - Unpaid accounts receivable may be assigned for collection. If an account is assigned, any collection costs, court costs, and/or attorney's fees owed will be added to the balance due. The balance due may be reported to national credit bureaus, which may adversely effect credit ratings. A hold will be placed on transcript records and future enrollment until the balance is paid in full.

**2012 GRADUATION CHECKS** - Candidates for May graduation must complete an Application for Graduation in the Admissions Office for consideration for their diploma... Students who expect to complete degree requirements by the end of the spring 2012 term **MUST** contact the Admissions Office and (1) request a **Final Degree Check** prior to registering for the spring 2012 term and (2) complete an Application for Graduation before March 18, 2012 at the Office of Admissions and Records at the Warner or CSC Higher Education Center.

**COMMENCEMENT** - Commencement ceremony is held during May of each year. Students who have completed degree requirements during the previous summer and fall term may participate in the May commencement exercises. Contact the Admissions Office for more information.

**STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY** - Students are personally responsible for completing all requirements established for their degrees by the college and academic department. A student's advisor is not to assume any of these responsibilities and should not substitute, waive, or exempt the student from any requirement or academic standard.

**TO CANCEL ENROLLMENT** - If you cannot attend CSC after you enroll, you need to withdraw by a personal appearance or submit a written request to the Warner Campus Admission's Office by January 20, 2012 to cancel your enrollment for the spring 2012 semester and to receive a full refund. The written request must contain date, name, social security number, or student ID number, current address and your request to cancel your enrollment for the spring 2012, semester. **PLEASE NOTE: Non-payment and/or non-attendance do not constitute automatic withdrawal from classes. Students are responsible for payment if cancellation is not received by January 20, 2012.**

## **DUAL ENROLLMENT**

Students may earn credits at another institution in regular course work, extension, correspondence, distance education or online courses while currently enrolled in residence. Approval for dual enrollment must be secured in advance from the Executive Vice President or the credits will not be accepted. The total number of hours for dual enrollment must not exceed 19 in the spring/fall terms and 10 hours in the summer.

## **ENROLLMENT POLICY**

The Admissions Office will announce the enrollment start date. **Students must personally submit their enrollment card to the Admission's Office.** For additional information, check our website at [www.connorsstate.edu](http://www.connorsstate.edu) or (918) 463-2931, (918) 687-6747.

**PARKING PERMITS** are required at any Connors Campus. All students must park in designated areas outlined in the parking permit information. Parking permits are available in the **Bursar Office, Gatlin Hall, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Warner Campus or the Bursar Office, Muskogee Higher Education Center.**

**STUDENT ID CARDS** are issued to all new students once tuition and fees are paid. All returning students are required to get their ID card validated each semester once tuition and fees are paid. Student ID cards are issued at the **Warner Bursar Office, Gatlin Hall, 1<sup>st</sup> Floor, Warner Campus, or the Muskogee Higher Education Center.** Lost cards are replaced at a cost of \$10.00. Student ID cards allow access to the library, bookstore, cafeteria, and college-sponsored activities. Your CSC student ID card is required for services in the Admissions Office and testing as well as in the Bursar Office to inquire about your account and to pick up checks.

**STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES** who require special accommodations must register with the **VP for Enrollment Management and Student Services, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus (918) 463-6308.** Prior to each semester, students must provide sufficient notification of all anticipated needs including documentation of medical, educational and/or psychological conditions.

The maximum number of hours that a student can enroll in is 19 credit hours in a spring or fall semester and 10 credit hours in the summer session. This is a combined number of hours from CSC, including arranged classes, and any other college or university that the student attends during the semester. If enrolled at CSC and another institution during the same semester, the student must fill out Permission for Dual Enrollment form. Forms can be obtained from the Admission's Office.

## TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS

Beginning January 2011 all Northeastern State University campuses will be "Tobacco Free". This includes the NSUM campus and Nursing at NSU Tahlequah.

## HOUSING POLICY

- All single students under the age of 20 and living beyond a 50-mile radius from the CSC Campus where they are enrolled are required to live in Campus housing.
- Exceptions can be made for one of the following reasons:
  - Being married
  - Being a single parent
  - Being 20 years of age or older
  - Living with parent or guardian within 50 miles
  - Being a veteran, or
  - Being a part-time student (enrolled in less than 12 hours)
- Students are not permitted to finalize their enrollment until their housing status is determined.
- Housing, tuition and fees will be subtracted each semester from first available money.
- Connors State College will enforce its housing policy.
- The Housing Policy refers to Warner Campus only.
- A housing application fee of \$55.00 is due at time of application submission and payment is to be made at the Bursar office window of Gatlin Hall.
- This fee is **Non-Refundable**.



## OFFICIAL NOTICE

**Immunization Requirements for Connors State College** Beginning with the fall semester 2004, Oklahoma state law requires that all new students, who attend Oklahoma colleges and universities for the first time, provide proof of immunization for certain diseases. If you cannot verify your Measles, Mumps, Rubella (2 doses each) and Hepatitis B (3 doses) immunization records, you will need to be re-immunized or sign a written waiver. Medical, religious and personal exemptions are allowed by law; such requests must be made in writing using the CSC Certificate of Exemption form available in the Registrar's office. Once received, Immunizations and/or copies of immunization records cannot be released to anyone. Please provide only a copy of your records and maintain the original for your files. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN A HOLD BEING PLACED ON FUTURE ENROLLMENT** **Specific information regarding immunization for meningitis:** Oklahoma law requires that first time enrollees who reside in **on-campus student housing** be vaccinated against meningococcal disease UNLESS, 1) the individual signs a written waiver that he/she has reviewed the information provided by CSC regarding meningitis immunization and has chosen not to be immunized, or, 2) in the case of a minor, the individual's parents or guardian signs such written waiver

## Spring 2012 ACT Residual Dates

**All students under the age of 21 are required to have an ACT test prior to enrolling at Connors State College.**

The **Residual ACT** is given for the convenience of prospective students who did not participate on a National Testing Date. Residual ACT test scores cannot be sent to other colleges or universities without first attending Connors. Cost of the Residual ACT is \$35.00 payable at the door by cash, check, or money order. No pre-registration is required. The fee cannot be charged and must be paid at check-in on the day the test is taken.

Prior to taking the Residual ACT test students should have completed and submitted an Application for Admission to Connors State College. To take the Residual ACT test you must have: (1) a valid photo ID, (driver's license, CSC ID card, etc.), (2) \$35.00, and (3) you must be at the test site 15 minutes before the testing time. **You may use a pocket calculator on the math section of the test.**

The Residual ACT test may be taken more than once, however, students MUST wait 60 calendar days in-between testing dates (National ACT participation is not affected by/does not affect this rule). **If you have taken the ACT Residual at this campus or any other, you MUST wait 60 days from that test date before you may test again.** For additional information call (918) 463-2931, Ext. 6300 or email [kwanna.king@connorsstate.edu](mailto:kwanna.king@connorsstate.edu)

# **PAYMENT INFORMATION**

## **TUITION AND FEES**

Payment or arrangements to pay should be completed on or before Monday, January 9, 2012 with the Bursar Office.

Payments may be made with cash, check, money order, VISA, MasterCard, and Tuition Management Systems or previously approved financial aid. Students receiving funding through an outside agency must provide a letter of authorization from the agency to the Bursar Office to process payment for their enrollment.

## **PAY BY CREDIT CARD**

Connors State College accepts MasterCard and VISA cards for payment of tuition and fees. Payments may be made in person or via the Connors website.

## **PAY BY THE MONTH (TMS)**

A financing option is being offered through **Tuition Management Systems** ([www.afford.com](http://www.afford.com).) If requested by student, **Tuition Management Systems** will contact prospective students by mail with information on enrollment in this plan. In addition, students may apply for this financing method by accessing the Connors State College home page at [www.connorsstate.edu](http://www.connorsstate.edu). Follow the link to "Tuition and Fees". Click on the link "Payment Plan/Tuition Management Systems" and follow the instructions shown.

All plans are interest free, but there is a one-time non-refundable enrollment fee charge of \$52.00. The enrollment fee may be charged to the student's account. Payments are due on the fifteenth of each month with a \$35.00 late fee on any payment not received by the twenty-fifth. This option is designed to offer interest-free financing for educational expenses. The options include the following plans:

This plan also includes life insurance in the amount of college expenses on the primary payer of the account until paid. Payments may be made by check, money order, Western Union Phone-Pay, VISA, MasterCard, and E-payment on the web or automatic debit (ACH).

## **STUDENTS WITH FINANCIAL AID**

Students who have returned a signed "Financial Aid Award Notification" from the financial aid office may have aid available for institutional charges. Financial aid funds will be applied toward your Bursar account including tuition, fees, books, supplies, fines, room and board before any overpayments will be issued.

To receive priority consideration for 2012, students seeking federal student aid MUST complete and mail the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on-line no later than Friday, July 30, 2012. Financial aid recipients whose circumstances require that they withdraw from all classes are strongly encouraged to contact the CSC Financial Aid Office and their academic advisor before doing so. At that time, the consequences of withdrawing from all classes can be explained. The federal government requires that students who withdraw from all classes may only keep the financial aid they have "**earned**" up to the time of withdrawal. Title IV funds (except federal work-study) that were disbursed in excess of the earned amount must be returned by CSC and/or the student to the federal government. This situation could result in the student owing aid funds to CSC, the government, or both. The CSC Financial Aid Office staff can provide examples of return of funds calculations and further explain this policy to students or parents.

## **REFUNDS FOR COMPLETE AND PARTIAL WITHDRAWALS**

<b>100% Refund</b>	Students withdrawing completely from Connors State College or from an individual <u>16 week class</u> during the first two weeks Monday, January 9, 2012, through January 20, 2012 will receive a 100% refund. The final day to withdraw for a <u>first eight week class</u> and receive a refund is January 20, 2012.
<b>No Refund</b>	Withdraw from an individual class or totally withdraw from regular 16 week classes after January 20, 2012.

## **STUDENTS RECEIVING SCHOLARSHIPS, REHAB, FEE WAIVERS, OR FINANCIAL AID**

Awards **ARE NOT** automatically credited to your account. Students receiving tuition, fees, books or room & board assistance must appear **in person**, during Enrollment Week, or no later than January 20, 2012, at the Bursar Office in Warner or Muskogee to receive these awards. # Fundamentals of Computer Advanced Standing Test

## Testing Fee \$15.00

Students wishing to take the Advanced Standing Test for COMS 1133 should contact Mr. Mani Shanmugamani at the Muskogee Higher Education Center (ext. 5445) or email to [schinna@connorsstate.edu](mailto:schinna@connorsstate.edu) or Ms. Gina Jones on the Warner Campus (ext. 6307) or email to [gina.jones@connorsstate.edu](mailto:gina.jones@connorsstate.edu) to make arrangements to take the exam within the first two weeks of the start of the semester. Once the day and time is established, the student must obtain the Placement Test Referral Form from the Admissions Office, present the form to the Bursar Office and pay the \$15.00 testing fee. Student will give the Placement Test Referral Form to the instructor and show their bursar office receipt. The instructor will submit the test form to the Admissions Office after testing. Students who pass the exam will be required to pay a transcript fee of \$10 per credit hours (\$30.00).

### Introduction:

All students who plan to graduate this semester **must** enroll in and attend EDUC 2320, Outcomes Assessment. There is no (zero) charge for this course. Outcomes Assessment testing sessions will be conducted during one 2-week testing period each semester (see Testing Dates below). Students who do **not** attend a testing session within the 2-week testing period must wait until the subsequent semester to enroll in and attend Outcomes Assessment.

### Course Description:

Outcomes Assessment is a 4-hour, exit-testing session during which the academic achievement of graduating students is assessed in the areas of Writing Skills, Mathematics, Reading, and Science by utilizing the **CAAP** test. The **Collegiate Assessment of Academic Proficiency (CAAP)** is the standardized, nationally normed assessment program published by the ACT Company. The purpose of the **CAAP** testing is to enable Connors State College to **assess**, **evaluate**, and **enhance** the outcomes of its general education program.

★ *Outcomes Assessment is a prerequisite for graduation from Connors State College.*

**One College Level Mathematics Class**

**Two College Level Science Classes (Including One Lab Science Class)**

### Requirements:

Participation in EDUC 2320 class on Blackboard  
 Bring & show your CSC student ID at the CAAP test  
 Bring a #2 (**NOT MECHANICAL**) pencil  
 Bring a permitted calculator  
 Arrive 15 minutes before the session is to begin

### Testing Rules:

No late entry

# Admissions Process at Connors State College

Before enrollment, the following must be on file in the Admissions/Registrar's Office.

## FIRST-TIME COLLEGE STUDENTS

1. A completed Admissions Application
2. Students age **twenty (20) and younger** (high school class must have graduated) must provide:
  - a. An official high school transcript with date of graduation or last date of attendance
  - b. ACT or SAT scores
  - c. COMPASS Placement Test scores if ACT sub-scores are less than 19
3. Students age **twenty-one (21) or older** must provide:
  - a. Official high school transcript with date of graduation or last date of attendance
  - b. COMPASS Placement Test (CPT) scores (may use ACT if sub-scores are 19 or above), or voluntary remediation of all courses
4. Provide immunization documentation

## TRANSFER STUDENTS

1. A completed Admissions Application
2. Official transcript(s) from all colleges attended
3. An official high school transcript and ACT scores if student has earned fewer than 24 credit hours or if student seeks to prove history curricular requirement has been met
4. Provide immunization documentation

## ENTRY-LEVEL ASSESSMENT

The Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education have established minimum ACT Scores as the initial determinant for individual student readiness for college level work. Students who do not have the required ACT scores (19) in the various subject areas will be required to sit for the COMPASS test(s) to determine placement in developmental courses. COMPASS Testing takes from one to two hours to complete depending on the number of tests required. Please keep this in mind when you come to campus to enroll. COMPASS testing is conducted from 8:00 AM to 2:00 PM daily at both the Main Campus in Warner and the Downtown Campus in Muskogee.

## Final Degree Check and Applying for Graduation

**What is the difference between graduation and commencement?** **GRADUATION** is the term for completing your course of study at Connors State College and fulfilling all the requirements for your degree, as outlined on the degree plan.

**COMMENCEMENT** refers to the *ceremony* celebrating those who are receiving their degrees from Connors State College in a given year. At the commencement ceremony, the President of the college symbolically confers degrees on candidates. Attending commencement is not required to graduate from Connors State College or to receive your diploma; however, ***you must apply for graduation to receive your diploma.*** Only one commencement ceremony is held each year, which is held in May. All graduates from the previous summer and fall terms are invited to participate. The commencement participation deadline is completed when you apply for graduation. Nursing students participating in the Pinning Ceremony are encouraged to participate in the Commencement program.

Participation in the commencement ceremony does not constitute that the student has met all requirements for graduation. Students who have completed all, or who lack six or less credit hours (electives) with a 2.00 or better are eligible to participate in commencement. Students applying for May graduation and participating in commencement are only *candidates for graduation*.

**Applying for Graduation.** Each student must make application for his/her degree no later than the filing date specified in the academic calendar located on the website and in the class schedule. The application must be completed through the Office of Admissions, Warner/Muskogee along with a final degree check. An application fee of \$35.00 will be billed to your account for the first degree, and \$5.00 for a subsequent degree earned *within the same term*. Students must complete an application to graduate. ***There is a graduation application deadline. Missing the deadline may delay your graduation date to the summer term. Deadline information is printed in the class schedule.***



Degrees are awarded at commencement exercises held at the end of the spring semester in May; however, the diploma and transcript will reflect the term in which *all* requirements were completed and will be mailed to the student's address listed on the Application for Graduation.

**About your diploma.** All official Connors State College dipomas are printed through an outside vendor. Dipomas ***are not*** distributed during the commencement ceremony, but mailed to students that successfully completed the degree requirements with a 2.00 grade point average or better and after all financial and academic obligations are met. Diplomas are mailed *approximately*:

May Graduation:	2 <sup>nd</sup> week in August
Summer Graduation	2 <sup>nd</sup> week in October
December Graduation	2 <sup>nd</sup> week in March

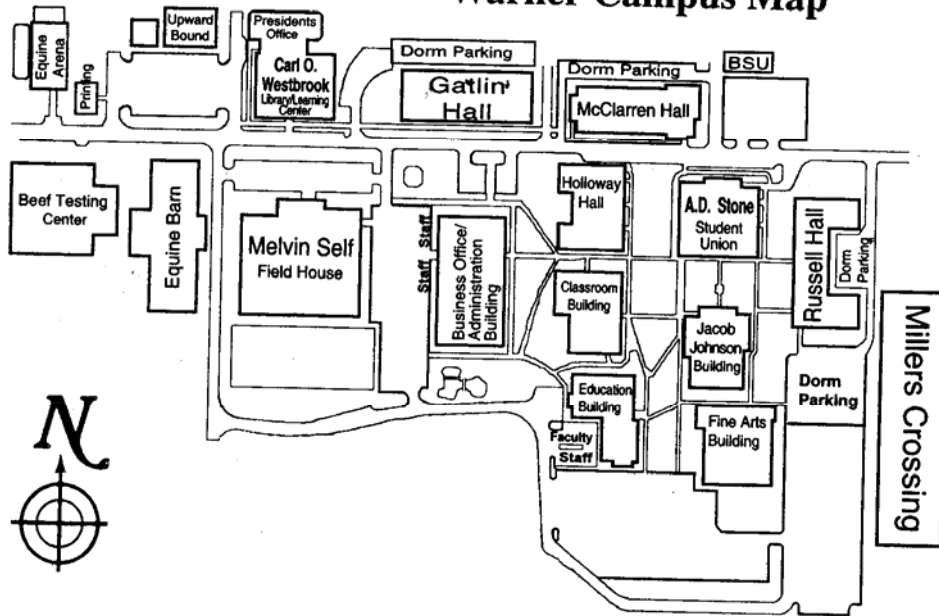

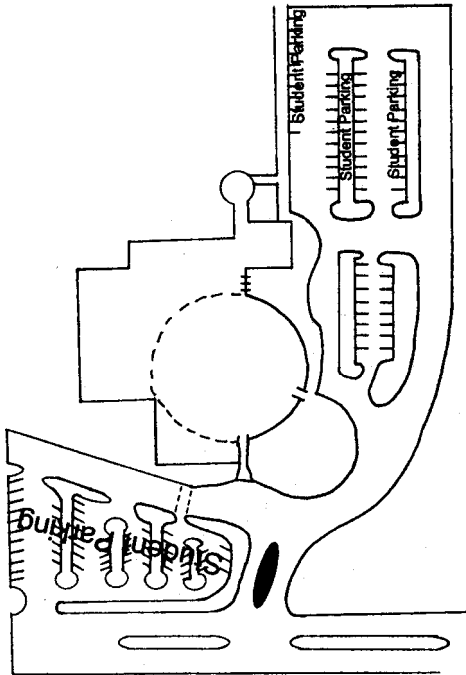

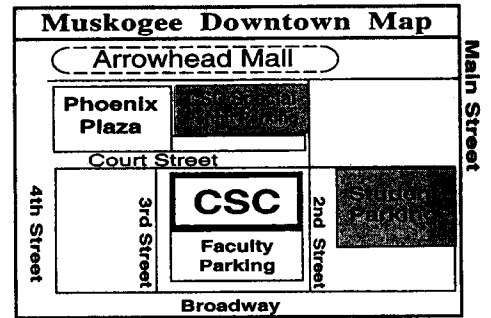
## Warner Campus Map
