GENERAL INFORMATION

ENROLLMENT POLICY

Announcement will be made by the Admissions/Registrar's Office of the enrollment start date. Students must obtain a Permit to Enroll from the Admissions Office, personally complete an enrollment card with their advisor, and submit the card to the Admissions Office.

NEW STUDENTS should submit an application and other requirements at least one month prior to enrollment. For details contact the **Admissions Office, Gatlin Hall, First Floor, Warner Campus; the Admission Office Room 108, Muskogee West Campus; or the Port Campus, Room 1.**

ENTRY LEVEL ASSESSMENT is required of all first-time students seeking admission into degree programs. The purpose of assessment is to assist faculty and advisors in helping students to succeed in attaining their educational goals. Assessment is required in English, math, reading and science. All course remediation requirements must be completed within the first 24 credit hours.

COLLEGE ORIENTATION SPRING 2014

Each academic division requires a College Orientation class for all full-time first term freshmen, transfer students with fewer than 24 hours or who are admitted on probation. A variety of topics are discussed to assist the student in being successful in college.

READMISSION OF FORMER STUDENTS - Students who have attended CSC but have not been enrolled in more than one year must be readmitted. Students who have enrolled in another college since attending CSC must submit official transcripts (in a sealed envelope from the college/university attended) of all work attempted before readmission can be granted. For details, contact the **Admission/Registrar's Office, 1st Floor, Gatlin Hall, Warner Campus; the Admission Office Room 108, Muskogee West Campus; or the Port Campus, Room 1.**

ACADEMIC ADVISEMENT SERVICES will assist all students with the enrollment process. For details/assistance, contact **any academic advisor on the Warner, Muskogee West or Port Campuses.**

FULL TIME STUDENTS must be enrolled in at least 12 -19 hours during a Spring or Fall semester. Summer semester full-time students must be enrolled in at least 6-10 hours. Part-time students enroll in 11 or fewer hours in the Spring or Fall and 5 hours or less in the summer.

VETERANS – All persons receiving VA educational benefits must report to the **VA Education Office, Muskogee West Campus (918) 687-6747, ext. 5443.** All class schedules must have prior approval to receive educational benefits. To determine eligibility, students should contact the **Department of Veterans' Affairs, toll free at 1-888-442-4551 or visit the VA Regional Office at Okmulgee and Main, Muskogee, Oklahoma.**

VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION BENEFITS are available through the Vocational Rehabilitation Division of the State Board of Education for payment of tuition and other services to students who have substantial employment handicaps. A representative of the Division must approve the vocational objective selected by the student. For additional information, contact your **county or regional Vocational Rehabilitation Office. EVALUATION OF MILITARY CREDIT

Connors State College does not automatically award military credit to students at enrollment. A military credential evaluation is optional and has no bearing on admission into *Connors State College*. However, after a degree-seeking student is at *Connors State College* and earned 12 hours, he or she may request that the military record be evaluated by the Registrar's Office. Credit is evaluated using the ACE Guide for evaluation of military credit (Army, Navy, Air Force, and Coast Guard). No credit will be awarded based on Military Occupancy Specialty (MOS) which has not held a primary duty assignment for a minimum duration of one year or more.

It is the responsibility of the student to provide the information below for evaluation. Evaluation will begin upon receipt of the following documents.

- (1) Military Training Evaluation
Send a copy of your DD-214 or a DD-295
- (2) MOS Evaluation
Your current primary MOS can be reviewed for possible credit if you received an official evaluation within the last 12 months.

Students will not be certified for VA benefits after the first regular semester until the College's VA Certifying Officer has received the DD-214 and any other transcripts for evaluation.

Connors State College awards the credit listed below where appropriate to all veterans that have completed two years of active duty as verified by the veteran's DD-214.

HLTH 1113 Personal Health (3 credit hours)

PHED 1122 First Aid (2 credit hours)

Students will be given Advanced Standing credit and charged \$10.00 per credit hour for the above hours. Credit earned is designated on the transcript by the letter "P".

E-MAIL GUIDELINES

Your Connors' C-Key (campus email) is the primary means of communication with students accepted to Connors State College. Activate your *Connors'* e-mail account. This is how to communicate with CSC and your instructors. Your *Connors* student e-mail address (**C-Key**) serves as a critical component of our College's ability to communicate with you. Via this e-mail address, you will continually receive official CSC correspondence, updates, billing notification, emergency announcements as well as information concerning your enrollment in the Admission's Office. At the time of Admission and/or enrollment, you will be asked to provide the Admission's Office with your personal or alternate e-mail address to receive your PIN number and confirmation. Please ensure that the email address provided is a private and reliable address to which you, the applicant, will have access during the entire admissions process. In addition, this enables us to send assistance directly to you if you forget your password or become locked out of the system. It is very important to activate your account prior to enrollment so that you may receive these materials. Students should consider proper online etiquette as well as the Student Code of Conduct when writing and submitting e-mail to instructors and other campus officials. Using profane or otherwise abusive language can have a negative impact on the student's standing in the course as well as CSC, and can possibly bring disciplinary action.

DEGREE PLANS - Degree plans will remain in effect provided the student has had continuous enrollment. Students who leave and then reenter will be subject to any new degree or general education requirements. Students should have two degree checks in the Admissions Office during their tenure. One at the 35 hour mark and one the semester prior to graduating. Only those degree checks performed in the Admissions Office will be considered for graduation.

ACADEMIC FORGIVENESS POLICY - Students may repeat up to four classes (not to exceed 18 hours) of "D" or "F" grades and have only the last grade earned used in the calculation of the retention and graduation GPA. In certain circumstances, students may apply for an academic reprieve for up to two consecutive semesters of course work. Students must apply for academic renewal for removal of all previous coursework. **If repeating a course, it is necessary to inform the Admission's Office.** For more information regarding the Academic Forgiveness Policy, contact the Admission's Office or the CSC catalog.

ACADEMICALLY INELIGIBLE TO RE-ENROLL - If you enroll early and are found to be ineligible by admissions/enrollment standards, the Admission's Office will notify you and your enrollment will be canceled. Should you become academically ineligible and wish to appeal the decision, the first step in the appeal process is to submit a letter of appeal to the Vice President for Academic Affairs, Connors State College, Route 1, Box 1000, Warner, OK 74469 *immediately* for consideration for re-admission.

CLASS SCHEDULE CHANGES - Changes in schedule during the add/drop period will result in full charges for courses added and full refund for courses dropped. Refunds will not be made until after the defined add/drop period.

COLLECTION COSTS - Unpaid accounts may be assigned for collection. If an account is assigned, any collection costs, court costs, and/or attorney's fees owed will be added to the balance due. The balance due may be reported to national credit bureaus, which may adversely affect credit ratings. A hold will be placed on transcript records and future enrollment until the balance is paid in full.

2014 GRADUATION CHECKS - Candidates for May graduation must complete an Application for Graduation in the Admission's Office for their diploma. Students who expect to complete degree requirements by the end of the Spring 2014 term **MUST** contact the Admissions Office and (1) request a **Final Degree Check** prior to registering for the Spring 2014 term and (2) complete an Application for Graduation before March 24, 2014 at the Office of Admissions and Records at the Warner, Muskogee West or Port Campuses.

COMMENCEMENT - A commencement ceremony is held in May each year. Students who have completed degree requirements during the previous Summer and Fall term may participate in the May commencement exercises. Contact the Admissions Office for information.

STUDENT RESPONSIBILITY - Students are personally responsible for completing all requirements established for their degrees by the college and academic department. A student's advisor is not to assume any of these responsibilities and should not substitute, waive, or exempt the student from any requirement or academic standard.

TO CANCEL ENROLLMENT - If you cannot attend CSC after you enroll, you need to withdraw by a personal appearance or submit a written request to the Warner Campus Admission's Office by January 24, 2014 to cancel your enrollment for the Spring 2014 semester and to receive a full refund. The written request must be postmarked on or before January 24 and contain date, name, social security number, or student ID number, current address and your request to cancel your enrollment for the Spring 2014, semester.

PLEASE NOTE: Non-payment and/or non-attendance do not constitute automatic withdrawal from classes. Students are responsible for payment if cancellation is not received by January 24, 2014.

DUAL CREDIT

Students may earn credits at another institution in regular course work, extension, correspondence, distance education or online courses while currently enrolled at CSC. Approval for dual credit must be secured in advance from the Vice President for Academic Affairs or the credits will not be accepted. The total number of hours for dual enrollment must not exceed 19 in the Spring/Fall terms and 10 hours in the summer.

STUDENTS' RIGHT-TO-KNOW AND CAMPUS SECURITY

ACT statistics are available in the CSC Catalog, Student Handbook, Chief of Campus Police Office, Holloway Hall, Warner Campus and on the CSC website www.connorsstate.edu. Graduation rates are available in the Admission's Office.

CONNORS STATE COLLEGE maintains a confidential file on each student. See *Access to Student Records* in the current CSC College Catalog for additional information regarding access to student records.

ENROLLMENT POLICY

The Admission's Office will announce the enrollment start date. **Students must personally submit their enrollment card to the Admission's Office.** For additional information, check our website at www.connorsstate.edu or (918) 463-2931, (918) 687-6747.

PARKING PERMITS are required at all Connors' Campus. All students must park in designated areas outlined in the parking permit information. Parking permits are available in the **Bursar's Office, Gatlin Hall, 1st Floor, Warner Campus; Bursar's Office, Admin Room 121, Muskogee West Campus; or Port Campus Room 1.** Parking permits are valid for a year and must be renewed every year in August.

STUDENT ID CARDS are issued to all new students once tuition and fees are paid. All returning students are required to get their ID card validated each semester once tuition and fees are paid. Student ID cards are issued at the **Warner Bursar's Office, Gatlin Hall, 1st Floor, Warner Campus; Muskogee Bursar's Office, Admin Room 121, Muskogee West Campus; or Port Campus, Room 1.** Student ID cards allow access to the library, bookstore, cafeteria, and college-sponsored activities. Your CSC student ID card is required for services in the Admissions Office and testing as well as in the Bursar Office to inquire about your account and to pick up checks. For your convenience, your CSC ID card can now be used as a pre-paid debit card on which your financial aid refund may be loaded.

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES who require special accommodations must register with the Coordinator for ADA Services at 918.463.6365 or kdp@connorsstate.edu, Holloway Hall, Warner Campus; NSUA Room 150, Muskogee West Campus, as soon as the student has enrolled in courses. Prior to each semester, students must provide sufficient notification of all anticipated needs including documentation of medical, educational and/or psychological conditions.

DON'T TAKE A CHANCE of having your GPA or academic record ruined. If, for any reason, you have enrolled and need to withdraw, contact the Office of Admissions, Gatlin Hall, 918-463-6300, Muskogee West Admissions Office at 918-687-6747 or Port Campus 918-684-5487 to properly withdraw from your classes

The maximum number of hours that a student can enroll in is 19 credit hours in a Spring or Fall semester and 10 credit hours in the Summer session. This is a combined number of hours from CSC, including arranged classes, and any other college or university that the student attends during the semester. If enrolled at CSC and another institution during the same semester, the student must fill out Permission for Dual Enrollment form. Forms can be obtained from the Admission's Office.

NOTICE

CSC reserves the right to cancel courses and programs due to low enrollment and other circumstances. The information herein does not constitute a contract between CSC and a student or any applicant for admission. Administrative decisions may affect the published details. This includes the fee schedule, which is subject to change at the direction of the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education.

CONCEALED WEAPONS POLICY prohibits the possession or use of firearms, firecrackers, explosives, or any other weapons or instruments designed to be destructive in nature on all CSC Campus grounds and buildings, except for use in officially approved college programs. Law enforcement officers may carry weapons in the performance of their duties and in accordance with Oklahoma Statutes.

DRUG/ALCOHOL PREVENTION PROGRAM

To that end, and based on the policies established by the Oklahoma A & M Board of Regents and state and federal laws, the College has established a program to aid in the prevention of drug and alcohol abuse by its students and employees.

TOBACCO FREE CAMPUS

In compliance with Executive Order 2012-01, Connors *Governor Mary Fallin in signed Executive Order 2012-01 which requires Connors and all properties owned, leased, or contracted by the State of Oklahoma to be tobacco free by July 6, 2012.

HOUSING POLICY

- All single students under the age of 20 and living beyond a 50-mile radius from the CSC Warner Campus are required to live in Campus housing.
- Exceptions can be made for one of the following reasons:
Being married
Being a single parent
Being 20 years of age or older
Living with parent or guardian within 50 miles
Being a veteran, or
- Being a part-time student (enrolled in less than 12 hours)
- Students are not permitted to finalize their enrollment until their housing status is determined.
- Housing, tuition and fees will be subtracted by semester from first available money.
- The Connors will enforce its housing policy.
- The Housing Policy refers to Warner Campus only.
- A housing application fee of \$55.00 is due at time of application submission and payment is to be made at the Bursar's office of Gatlin Hall.
- This fee is **Non-Refundable**.

Spring 2014 ACT Residual Dates

All students under the age of 21 are required to have an ACT test prior to enrolling at Connors.

The Residual ACT is given for the convenience of prospective students who did not participate on a National Testing Date. Residual ACT test scores cannot be sent to other colleges or universities without first attending Connors. Cost of the Residual ACT is \$35.00 payable at the door by cash, check, or money order. No pre-registration is required. The fee cannot be charged and must be paid at check-in on the day the test is taken.

Prior to taking the Residual ACT test students should have completed and submitted an Application for Admission to Connors State College. To take the Residual ACT test you must have: (1) a valid photo ID, (driver's license, CSC ID card, etc.), (2) \$35.00, and (3) you must be at the test site 10 to 15 minutes before the testing time. You may use a pocket calculator on the math section of the test.

The Residual ACT test may be taken more than once, however, students **MUST** wait 60 calendar days in-between testing dates (National ACT participation is not affected by/does not affect this rule). If you have taken the ACT Residual at this campus or any other, you **MUST** wait 60 days from that test date before you may test again. OFFICIAL NOTICE

Immunization Requirements beginning with the Fall semester 2004, Oklahoma state law requires that all new students who attend Oklahoma colleges and universities for the first time to provide proof of immunization for certain diseases. If you cannot verify your Measles, Mumps, Rubella (2 doses each) and Hepatitis B (3 doses) immunization records, you will need to be re-immunized or sign a written waiver. Medical, religious and personal exemptions are allowed by law; such requests must be made in writing using the CSC Certificate of Exemption form available in the Registrar's office. Once received, immunization records cannot be released to anyone. Please provide only a copy of your records and maintain the original for your files. **FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE REQUIREMENTS WILL RESULT IN A HOLD BEING PLACED ON FUTURE ENROLLMENT.** **Specific information regarding immunization for meningitis:** Oklahoma law requires that first time enrollees who reside in **On-Campus Student Housing** be vaccinated against meningococcal disease UNLESS, 1) the individual signs a written waiver that he/she has reviewed the information provided by CSC regarding meningitis immunization and has chosen not to be immunized, or, 2) in the case of a minor, the individual's parents or guardian signs such written waiver

PAYMENT INFORMATION

TUITION AND FEES

Payment or arrangements to pay should be completed on or before Monday, January 13, 2014 with the Bursar's Office.

Payments may be made in person with cash, check, or money order. VISA, MasterCard or Discover payments may be made via the Connors State College website. Students receiving financial aid and/or scholarships need to have this pre-approved and notated on their account before the first day of class. Students receiving funding through an outside agency must provide a letter of authorization from the agency to the Bursar Office to process payment for their enrollment prior to the first day of class. If students would like their Connors State College bookstore purchases included in their invoice to the outside agency providing funding, it is their responsibility to provide copies of the receipts to the Bursar Office for invoicing. Students who are not eligible for financial aid may enroll in our Payment Option Plan (POP) to cover the cost of tuition, fees, books, room and board for a small enrollment fee; please see details below.

MONTHLY PAYMENT PLAN(POP)

Connors State College offers a monthly Payment Option Plan (POP) for students who do not receive financial aid or simply need to fill a gap between charges and financial aid received. POP is an alternative means of paying for college that enables the student to charge their books, room & board in addition to their tuition & fees without having to pay the full amount up front at the beginning of the semester. Enrollment in this plan may be done in the Bursar Office. A non-refundable enrollment fee (\$25) is required at the time of enrollment in the plan and may be charged to the student's bursar account. We offer a 5 payment plan option and a 4 payment plan option. September is the last month eligible to enroll in the Fall Plan and February is the last month eligible to enroll for the Spring Plan. A late fee (\$20) is assessed if the payment is not received by the due date. Please contact the Bursar Office for details regarding this option; we want to help you be successful.

STUDENTS WITH FINANCIAL AID

Students who have returned a signed "Financial Aid Award Notification" from the Financial Aid Office may have aid available for institutional charges. Financial Aid funds will be applied toward your Bursar account including tuition, fees, books, supplies, fines, room and board before any overpayments will be issued.

To receive priority consideration for 2014-2015, students seeking federal student aid MUST complete and mail the free application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on-line no later than Friday, March 01, 2014. Financial aid recipients whose circumstances require that they withdraw from all classes are strongly encouraged to contact the CSC Financial Aid Office and their academic advisor before doing so. At that time, the consequences of withdrawing from all classes can be explained. The federal government requires that students who withdraw from all classes may keep only the financial aid they have "earned" up to the time of withdrawal. Title IV funds (except federal Work-Study) disbursed in excess of the earned amount must be returned by CSC and/or the student to the federal government. This situation could result in the student owing aid funds to CSC, the government, or both. The CSC Financial Aid Office staff can provide examples of return of funds calculations and further explain this policy to students or parents.

REFUNDS FOR COMPLETE AND PARTIAL WITHDRAWALS

100% Refund	Students withdrawing completely from Connors or from an individual <u>16 week class</u> during the first two weeks Monday, January 13, 2014, through January 24, 2014 will receive a 100% refund. The final day to withdraw for a <u>first 8-week class</u> and receive a refund is January 17, 2014.
No Refund	Withdraw from an individual class or total withdrawal from regular 16-week classes after January 24, 2014.

STUDENTS RECEIVING SCHOLARSHIPS, REHAB, FEE WAIVERS, OR FINANCIAL AID

Awards **ARE NOT** automatically credited to your account. Students receiving tuition, fees, books or room & board assistance must appear ***in person***, during Enrollment Week, or no later than January 24, 2014, at the Bursar's Office in Warner, Muskogee West or Port Campuses to receive these awards. Authorization to pay documents and/or scholarship notifications must be submitted to the Bursar Office. If students would like CSC bookstore purchases included on the invoice sent to the third party entity it is their responsibility to supply the Bursar Office with copies of their bookstore receipts. **All enrollments are final and binding on the student for financial obligations and academic records unless changed by January 24, 2014, the last scheduled drop-add date.**

Students will give the Placement Test Referral Form to the instructor and show his/her Bursar's office receipt. The instructor will submit the test form to the Admission's Office after testing. Students who pass the exam will be required to pay a transcript fee of \$10 per credit hours (\$30.00).

Blended Classes

Blended classes combine conventional classroom meetings with independent study via the Internet and e-mail. Blended courses combine the benefits of face-to-face courses with that of online learning. Students spend less time in the classroom, and more time interacting through online communications technologies.

Students will communicate with instructors by e-mail or through Blackboard WebCT especially if enrolled in an online or blended course.

Distance Education – ITV

The (ITV) code in the course listing denotes distance education classes that Connors is sending or receiving via interactive video. Online courses, available through the Internet, are also included in the schedule. Information about enrolling in distance education classes from other Oklahoma colleges and universities may be obtained by contacting the **CSC Distance Education e-mail** cscdisted@connorsstate.edu. Students should carefully read each syllabus and identify e-mail guidelines that the instructor(s) may have concerning e-mail.

Internet Classes

Internet courses at *Connors* provide an alternative to those students who, for whatever reason, are unable to participate in traditional on-campus courses. Because these courses are delivered via the Internet, it is assumed that students enrolling in these classes:

- are self-motivated, self-directed, and able to meet deadlines.
- have access to a computer and the Internet and possess basic Internet skills.
- are familiar with the MS Windows environment including file/folder manipulation.
- have basic computer application skills and are familiar with a word processor.
- are capable of sending and receiving e-mail.

Specific computer requirements may vary from course to course. Please consult with the instructor.

A list of the Spring 2014 Internet classes that were scheduled at the time this schedule went to print can be found on page 12. Along with the assumptions listed above, please consider the following before enrolling in an online class.

1. Some of the classes have mandatory on-campus orientation sessions. You must contact your instructor **prior** to the orientation if the session conflicts with another class or orientation.
2. Some of the classes have online orientations. Students should e-mail their instructors for instructions.
3. Some of the courses have on-campus testing or activity requirements.
4. Many of our Instructors use Blackboard WebCT as a Course Management System. These are marked on page 12. Please contact CSC Distance Education via e-mail cscdisted@connorsstate.edu.

Students who enroll in Internet On-Line Courses are required to contact their instructor via e-mail. **If a student fails to contact the instructor or complete the orientation, he/she will not be allowed to participate in the course.**

Students should consider proper etiquette as well as the student code of conduct when writing and submitting e-mail to instructors and students. Using profane or otherwise abusive language can have a negative impact on the student's standing in the course as well as CSC, and can possibly bring disciplinary action.



What's next? After you have enrolled in your spring classes.

Once you are enrolled in a class at Connors State College, please note the following:

- Make sure you have secured finances to pay for your tuition, fees, books, room and board for the Spring term by securing Financial Aid through the Financial Aid Office, setting up a payment plan with the Bursar's Office or contacting your paying agency concerning your charges for the term. An invoice for tuition and fees will be sent to you from the Bursar Office and can be viewed on the CSC website through Student Information Services. Tuition and fees are due on or before January 13, 2014.
- Once you have paid your tuition and fees or charged them through the Bursar's Office, returning students will have their CSC ID card activated and purchase their parking decal; new students will have a CSC student ID card made and purchase a parking decal. You will need your license tag number to purchase your parking decal.
- If you will be receiving Financial Aid this semester, you should contact the Office of Student Financial Aid at 918-463-6220 Warner or 918-684-5402 Muskogee to be certain everything is in place.
- Activate your C-Key account. Your PIN number is available through the Admissions Office via your personal email address you provided at enrollment.

Final Degree Check and Applying for December Graduation

What is the difference between graduation and commencement? **GRADUATION** is the term for completing your course of study at Connors and fulfilling all the requirements for your degree, as outlined on the degree plan.

COMMENCEMENT refers to the *ceremony* celebrating those who are receiving their degrees from Connors in a given year. At the Commencement ceremony, the President of the College symbolically confers degrees on candidates. Attending Commencement is not required to graduate from *Connors* or to receive your diploma; however, *you must apply for graduation to receive your diploma*. There is only one Commencement ceremony for the year, held in May. All graduates from the previous Summer and Fall term are invited to attend. The deadline to sign-up to participate in Commencement is at the time you complete your Application for Graduation. Nursing students participating in the Pinning Ceremony are encouraged to participate in the Commencement program also.

Participation in the commencement ceremony does not necessarily mean that the student has met all requirements for graduation. Students that have completed all, lack six or fewer credit hours (electives) with a 2.00 or better are eligible to participate in the commencement ceremony in May. Students applying for May graduation and participating in commencement are merely *candidates for graduation*.

Applying for Graduation. Each student must make application for his/her degree no later than the filing date specified in the Academic Calendar located on the website and in the class schedule. The application must be completed through the Office of Admissions, Warner/Muskogee along with a final degree check. An application fee of \$35.00 will be billed to your account for the first degree, and \$5.00 for a subsequent degree earned *within the same term*. Students must complete an application to graduate. ***There is a graduation application deadline. Missing the deadline may delay your graduation date to the summer term. Deadline information is printed in the class schedule.***



Degrees are awarded at commencement exercises held at the end of the Fall semester in May; however, the diploma and transcript will reflect the term in which *all* requirements were completed and will be mailed to the student's address listed on the Application for Graduation.

About your diploma. All official *Connors State College* diplomas are printed through an outside vendor. Diplomas ***are not*** distributed during the commencement ceremony, but mailed to students that successfully completed the degree requirements with a 2.00 grade point average or better and after all financial and academic obligations are met. Diplomas are mailed *according to the following schedule*:

May Graduation:	2 nd week in August
Summer Graduation	2 nd week in October
December Graduation	2 nd week in March

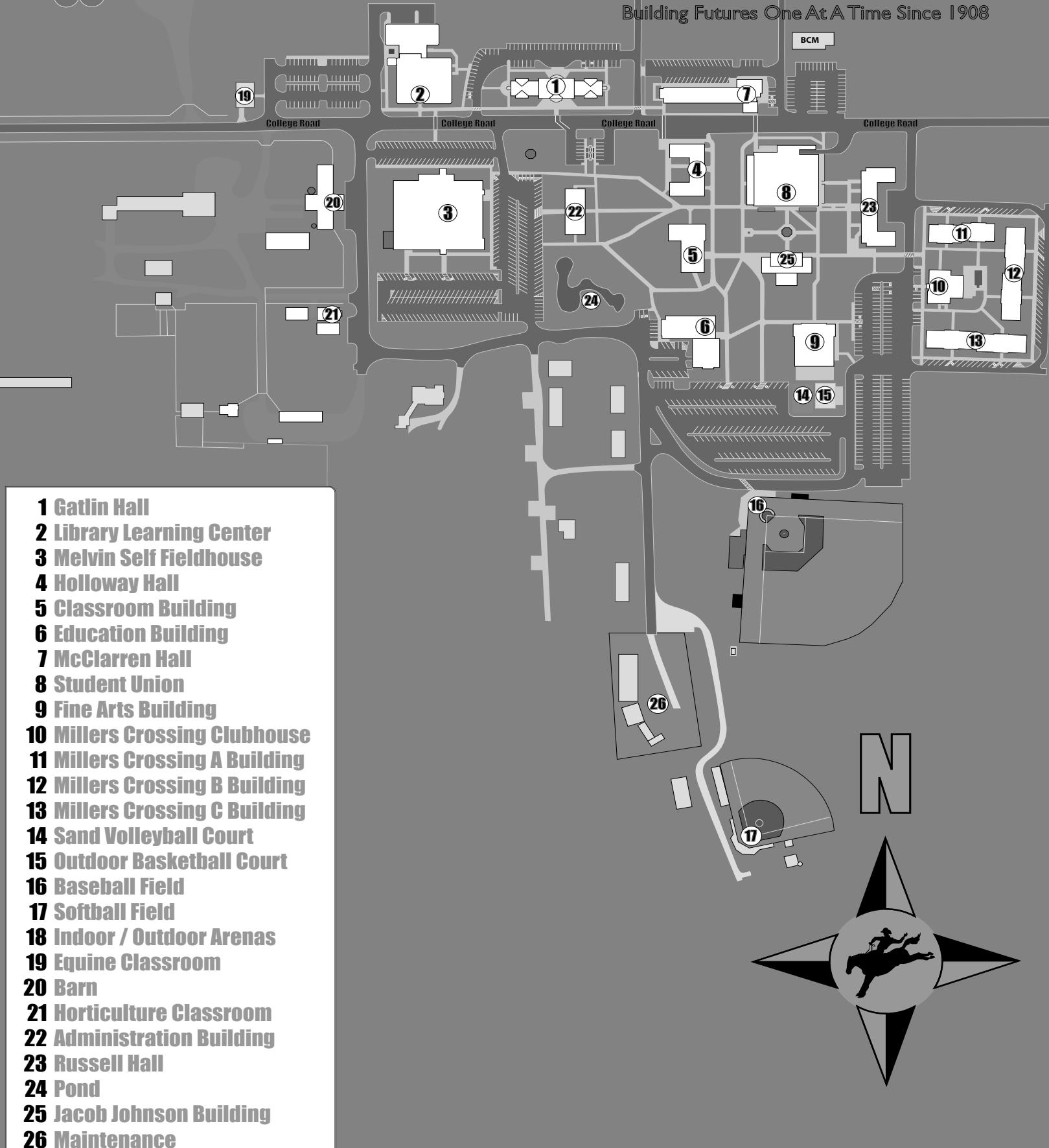

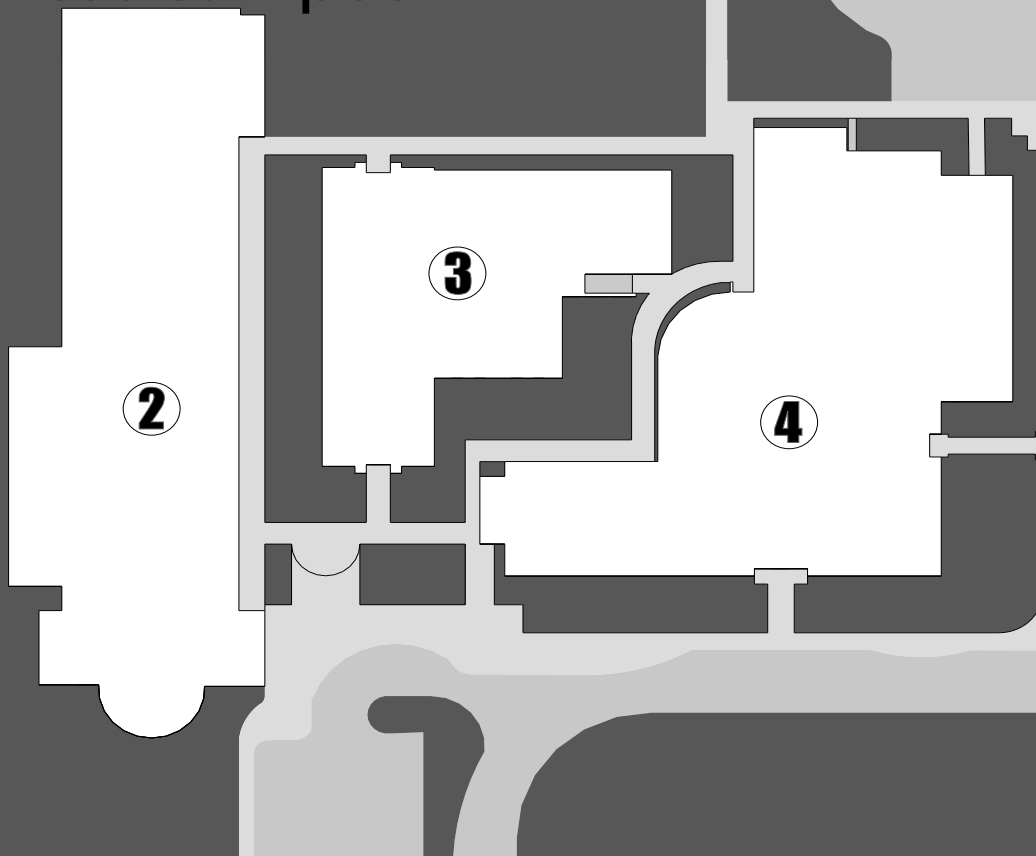
